

Disaster Event – Central Coast and Southern Queensland Trough, 26 – 30 March 2014



Event and Timing –

Significant rainfall occurred across central coast and southern areas of Queensland as a result of a low level trough and cloud band between 26 to 30 March 2014.

The Minister for Police, Fire and Emergency Services, The Honourable Jack Dempsey MP activated the Commonwealth/State Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Arrangements (NDRRA).

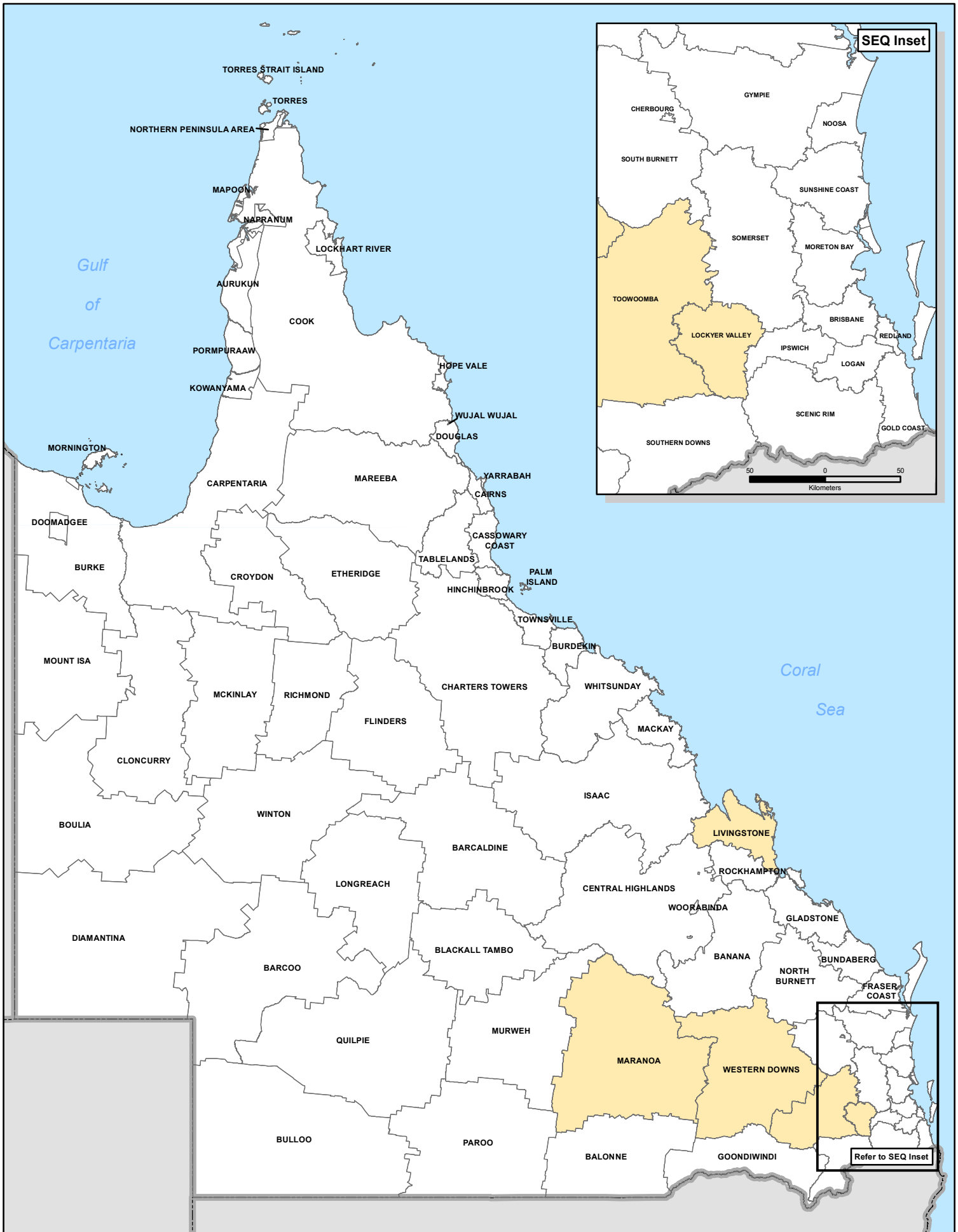
NDRRA Relief Measures Activated
